

## *Victorian Wristlets*



Needles: Sz 6 (set of 5 Double points)  
Yarn: Debbie Bliss Cashmerino 2 balls

Cast on 32 Stitches

Round 1-3 and 5-7: \*K2, P2 repeat from\*

Round 4: \*insert right hand needle (RHN) between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> stitches and draw through a loop, Slip the loop onto left hand needle(LHN) and knit it together with the first stitch on the LHN, K1,p2,k2,p2; repeat from\* to end.

Round 8: P2, K2, P2, \* insert RHN between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> stitches and draw through a loop, Slip the loop onto left hand needle LHN and knit it together with the first stitch on the LHN, k1, p2, k2, p2: repeat from \* end K2,P2.

Continue in K2, P2 until 4 inches long from beginning.

Split for thumb: slide the first stitch onto needle 4. (You will be working back and forth and you will want the border of your thumb stitches to look symmetrical)

Start Thumb:

Work row 1: in K1, \*P2, K2 Repeat from\*, until K1 at end of row.

When you end that round do not connect for round 2.... Instead work backwards (or from the inside)

Work row 2: P1, \*K2, P2 Repeat from \* until last stitch P1

You want to work back and forth in this manner to create the opening for your thumb

Repeat rows 1 &2 for 1 ½ inches.

Connect again to finish:

When you reach 1 ½ inches once again join in the round and continue in the K2, P2 ribbed pattern until desired length. (About an inch)

Picot Bind Off:

Cast off 1, \*knit 3 stitches into the next stitch, cast off 5. Repeat from \* to end.
